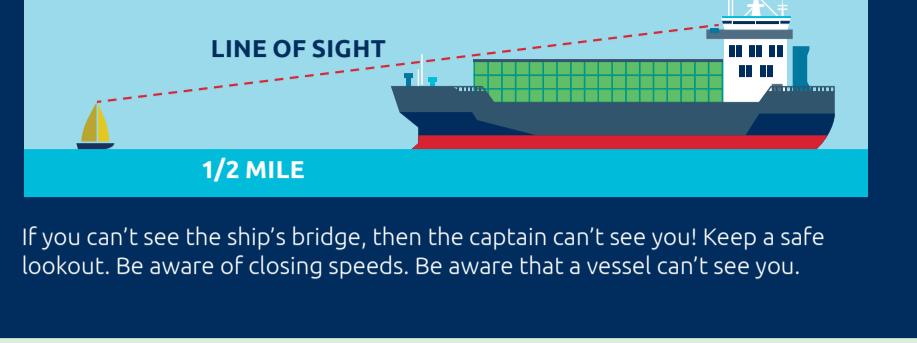

ALWAYS WEAR A LIFEJACKET

Danger may arise unexpectedly from the wash caused by passing vessels. We recommend you wear your lifejacket (with croch straps secured) at all times.

Navigation Warnings

Unit Moorings
Extensive unit yacht moorings will be encountered throughout the Rivers Deben, Orwell, Stour and Walton Backwaters. Commercial vessels navigating the rivers should be aware of these moorings, when staying overnight, to light their craft.

Lobster Pots
Some lobster pots are unmarked and there is a risk of fouling. Great care is required in the identified areas - especially at night time.

Recommended Yacht Crossing Points

Yachts and leisure craft should cross the main navigable channels at the recommended crossing points at right angles to the main craft flow. Keep well clear of commercial vessels crossing close ahead. Note that the recommended flow for yachts is seaward and small power driven commercial vessels may use this track.

Caution must be exercised at the entrance

Caution: The height of the tide may be affected by meteorological conditions. Winds between S.E. and S.W. or a high barometer, cause a decrease in height; winds between N.W. and N.E. or a low barometer, cause an increase. The deviation from the predicted tidal level may, under exceptional conditions, amount to more than one metre.

POWERED CRAFT RECREATIONAL ZONE

Outbound yachts crossing the channel, making for the yacht track should do so in order to ensure they are aware of any inbound commercial vessels.

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WALTON BACKWATERS SPEED LIMIT: 8 knots in seaward approaches and Harford Water, 6 knots in all creeks and channels & 4 knots in connected inland areas.

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Reduce speed to limit effects of boat wash and noise on the shore. Give other craft time and room to manoeuvre and do not anchor in busy fairways.

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
